## July 2008 Security Report

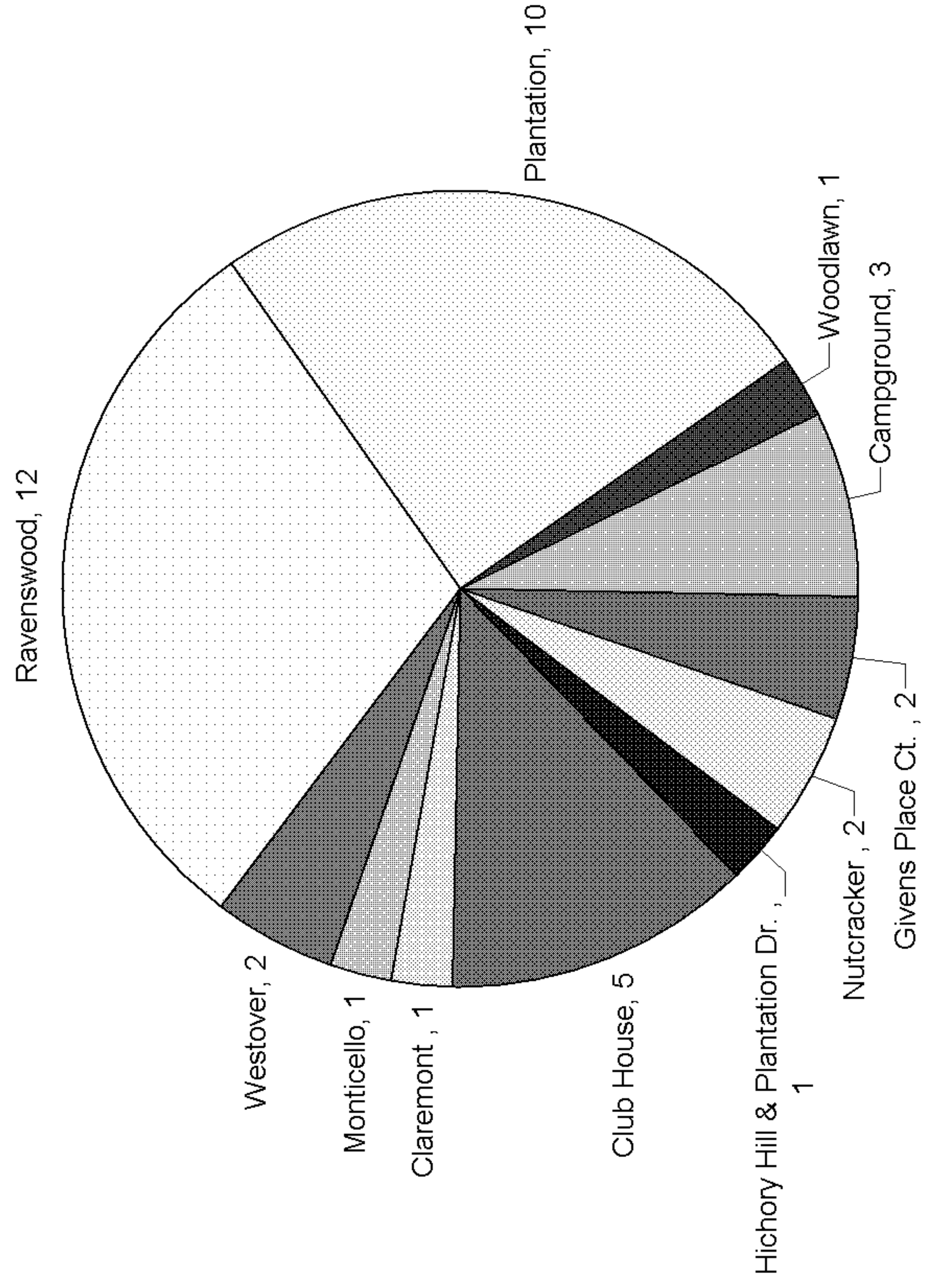
