
2-4-08 At 3:15pm ADT called Security for a silent alarm on Bellechase. Security went to the location and found all was secure.

The Sheriff's Office was called and after a field sobriety test found no drugs or alcohol involved. The driver was a guest and was issued a citation for reckless driving. 2-11-08 At 2:00am Security found that someone had tampered with the front exit gate. The Security officer resolved the matter and documented the time and date. When the video was reviewed the responsible party was identified. Security found that a Company out of Ft. Worth was repossessing a vehicle from a Pecan member and criminally trespassed our property. Security filed a report with the Sheriff's Office. Criminal Trespassing charges are forthcoming. A member in the Fairview area reported that the day before some kids were skateboarding on her property and in the neighbor's yard too. Security has stepped up awareness regarding the proper locations for skate boarding. 2-13-08 A member on Equestrian called to report that a suitcase was taken from his unlocked car two days ago. Someone found the suitcase on Mambrino Hwy. and called the member. 
2-25-08 A member reported that vandals shot paintballs onto his property on Joseph. Security went to the location to observe the damage and vandalism.
