Pecan Plantation February 2009 Security Report

2-1-09 At 2:15pm a member on Colonial reported that his golf clubs had been stolen from his garage the night before when he had his garage door open. Later he notified Security that he forgot he had left his clubs on his partner's cart.

2-9-09 At 9:45am a member in the Buena Vista area reported about 35 cows had crossed the river onto Pecan property and were headed towards the golf course. Hood County Sheriff's Office was contacted and the cattle went back across the river without incident. At 3:00pm a member dove into the cold water at the marina to catch another member's boat that was drifting away. He swam after the boat a short distance but was suddenly overcome and called for help. He quickly went under. Two individuals jumped in to help him but the water was too cold and they could not get to him. 911 was called and EMS was on the scene in less than 5 minutes but there was little they could do to locate and rescue him. He drowned and his body was recovered the next day.

2-11-09 At 11:00am a member reported two male teens knocked on her front door on Bellechase and asked to see a person that did not live there. She said she needed to speak to her husband and when she shut the door they ran away. She thought it was suspicious and called Security. Security located and identified the young men and spoke to the responsible member.

2-18-09 At 9:20am a member reported that someone hit and damaged their mailbox on Hanging Moss and did not stop to let them know. Later it was discovered that it was a school bus. School officials were contacted and the responsible party identified.




