May 2009 Security Report

5-6-09 At 6:30pm a member on Ravenswood reported that a few days before his vehicle was hit by a pellet rifle as he was driving in the area of Plantation Beach.

5-11-09 At 9:45am a member on Ravenswood reported a boat had been stolen from his property near the river. It was a 45 year old 10 foot aluminum john boat. He noticed the boat was missing the day before. It was also recommended to him to report the incident to the Hood County Sheriff's Office.

5-13-09 At 9:40am two vehicles collided on Ravenswood when one individual tried to pass while the other car was turning into their drive way. There were no injuries and minimal damage to the cars. They exchanged insurance information and went on their way.

5-16-09 At 11:20pm a member on Long reported that someone tried to take his daughter's picture through the bathroom window.

5-17-09 A member on Claremont reported three cracked window panes on their back porch and a light fixture that was taken from a pillar near the street. The member thinks it was done the night before.

5-19-09 A member on Hanover Ct. reported that glass blocks built into their mailbox had been broken. The member thinks it was done sometime in the past few days.

5-22-09 At 8:00am there was a report of spray painted graffiti on the back of the front gate marquee. This was reported to the Hood County Sheriff's Office. At 12:15pm a member on Ravenswood reported that someone had thrown a rock through his front storm door. The member heard the crash at 10:30am but did not find out what it was until later when he opened the front door.

5-23-09 At 11:50am a member reported her 13 year old son was missing. At 12:30pm the member called back saying they had found their son.

5-24-09 At the Memorial Day street dance two teenage males were issued citations from the Hood County Sheriff's Office for fighting. Also there was a bicycle reported stolen from the bike rack later that same night at the street dance.

5-25-09 At 3:20am a member and his guest that were fishing near the front gate bridge were vandalized including the guest's pickup window being broken out. The guest jumped into his pickup to follow the vandals and at a high rate of speed hit the exit gate arm and then the backend of the car he was following. The guest lost control and went off the road as the other car drove away. The guest then reported the incident to the Hood County Sheriff's Office. All parties have been identified and are paying for repairs and damages. At 6:00pm a member reported the lock on their locker at the marina boat slips was broken off and it's contents stolen.

5-27-09 At 6:20am a bicycle crash was reported on Ravenswood in the campground area. Security went to the location and found the rider and his wife who had come to get him. The rider stated that he was coming down the hill at a high rate of speed when three deer ran out in front of him. When he swerved to miss them he lost control and crashed. He had several injuries but refused to have 911 called. He wanted his wife to take him home so he could get cleaned up and then he would go see a doctor.

5-28-09 At 6:45am a member on Westover reported that sometime after dark someone stole a bag of golf clubs from his garage off of his golf cart. The member's garage door was left open all night. The member said they would also report the incident to the Hood County Sheriff's Office. At 5:10pm a member on Nutcracker reported that sometime the day before she believes someone stole her golf clubs from her golf cart when she was at the Medical Center or the Nutcracker Golf Club or Pecan Foods. It was also recommended to her to report this incident to the Hood County Sheriff's Office.

5-29-09 At 6:30pm a member reported two teenage boys shooting rifles in the 7400 block of Ravenswood. Security located them and took possession of the guns. Security then took each of the boys home and spoke to the parents letting them know this behavior is strictly prohibited and that fines will be coming.

5-30-09 At 9:00pm security identified a vehicle driving in the field across from the campground area causing extensive damage. It was later found out this vehicle had been driving recklessly and threw a liquid substance on to another car previously.

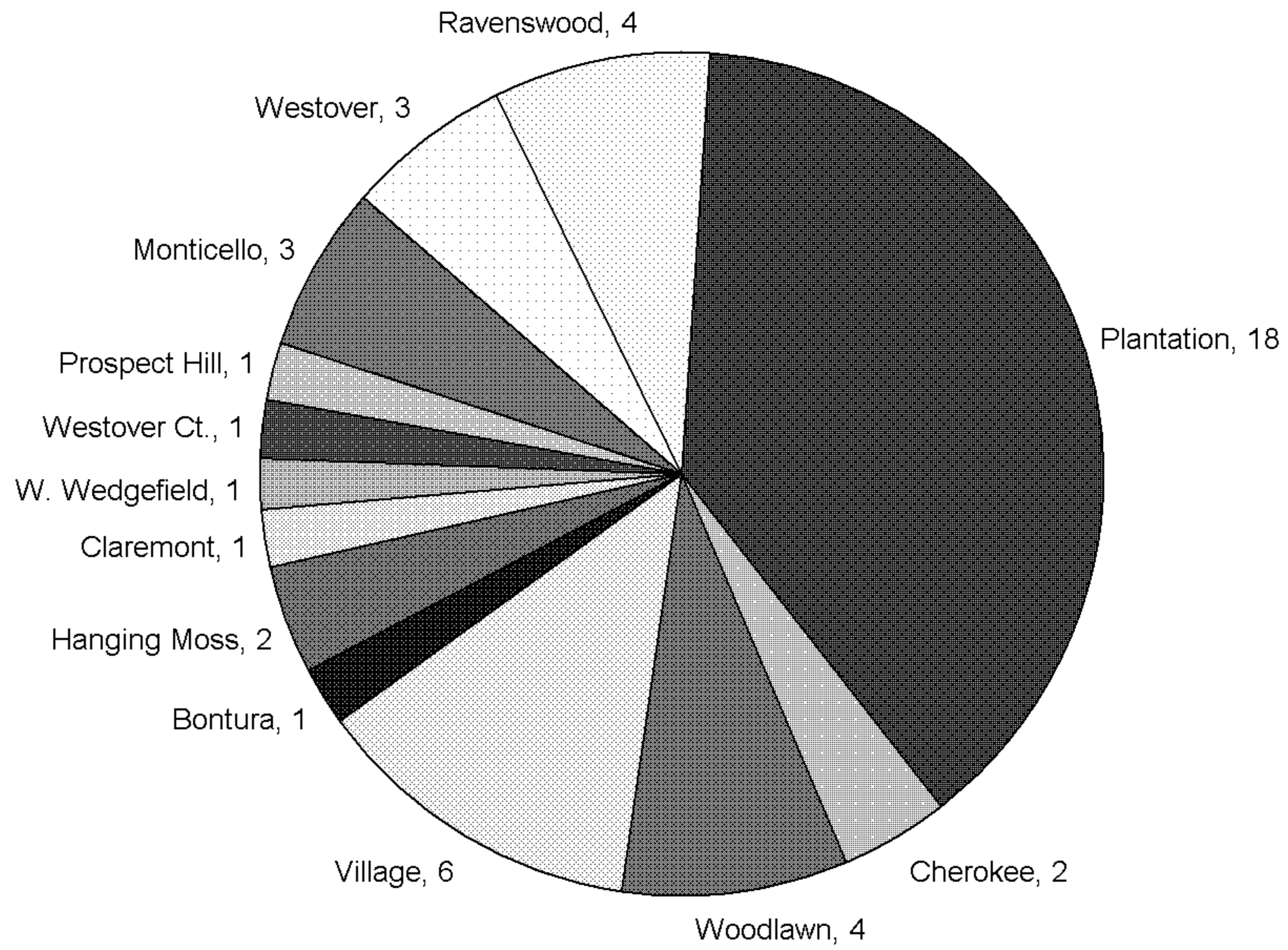

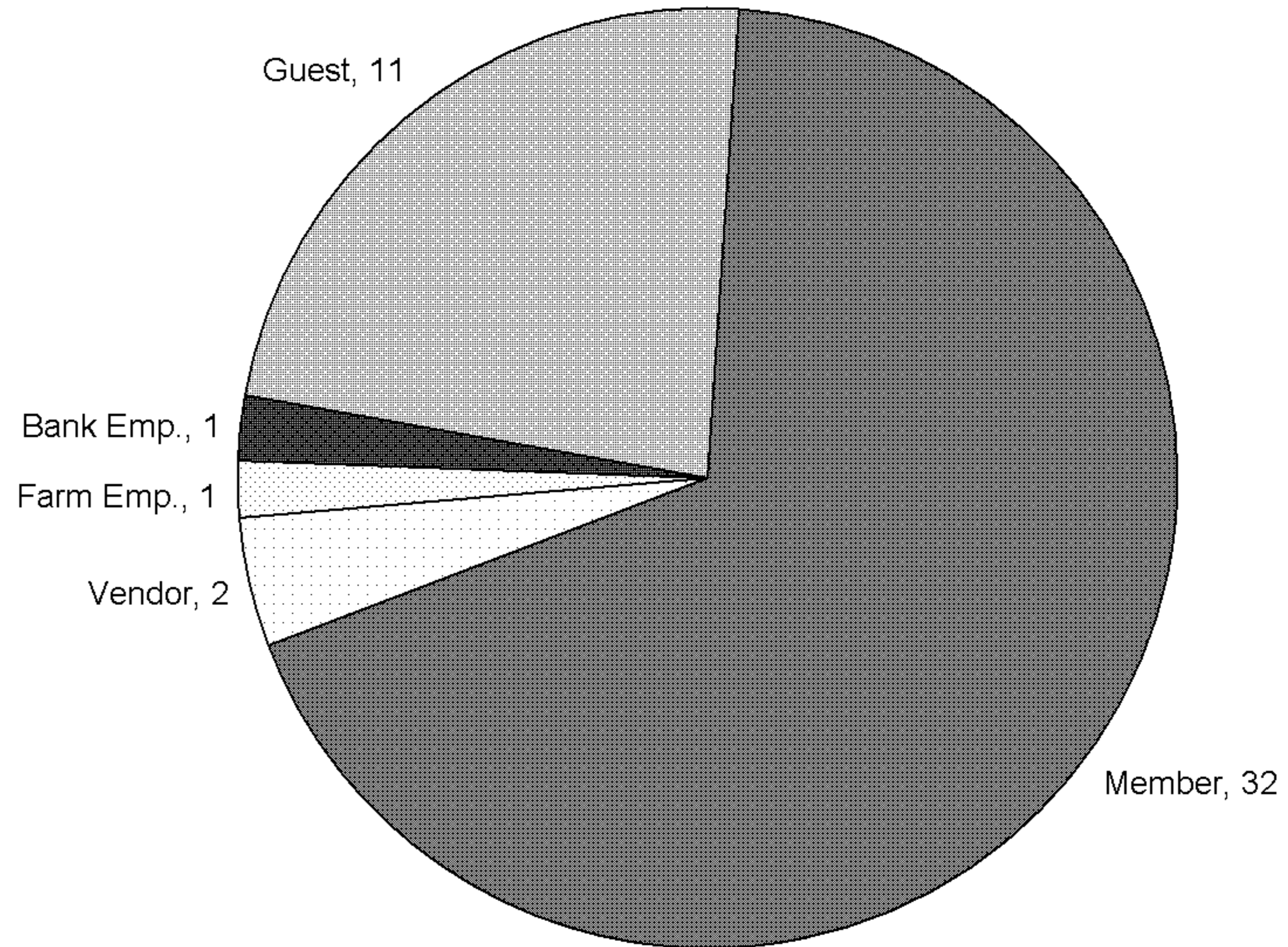
