October 2008 Security Report

10-3-08 A member on Bellechase reported an attempted theft of two yard gnomes by two teen girls driving a red golf cart.

10-9-08 Multiple reports from multiple locations came to Security about political signs being stolen from their yard the night before.

The speeder was caught and the member was fined.

10-13-08 At 1:40am a home on Claremont was found by Security to have been recently T.P.ed. At 9:20am a member on Sawgrass reported that two pumpkins were stolen from their property sometime the night before.

10-14-08 At 8:00am Hood County Animal Control put down a deer that was tangled in the soccer net at the PAC.

10-23-08 At 11:30pm a member requested Security be present at his house on Westover in case a dispute erupted when he went in to get his clothes. There was no incident of altercation.

10-27-08 At 5:50am Security received a report that hazard cones from the driving range area had been moved into the middle of Monticello. Security moved the cones back to the proper location.

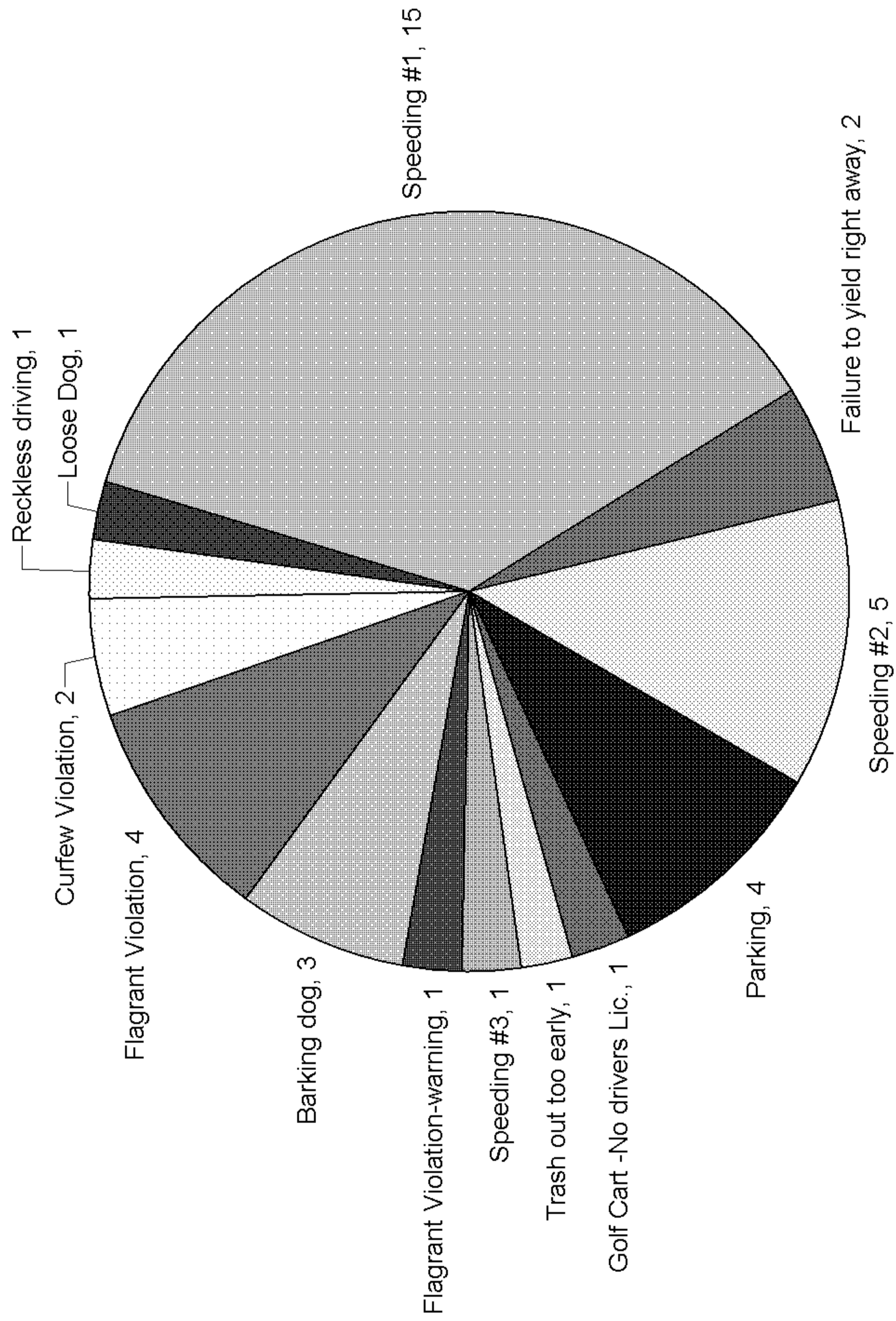

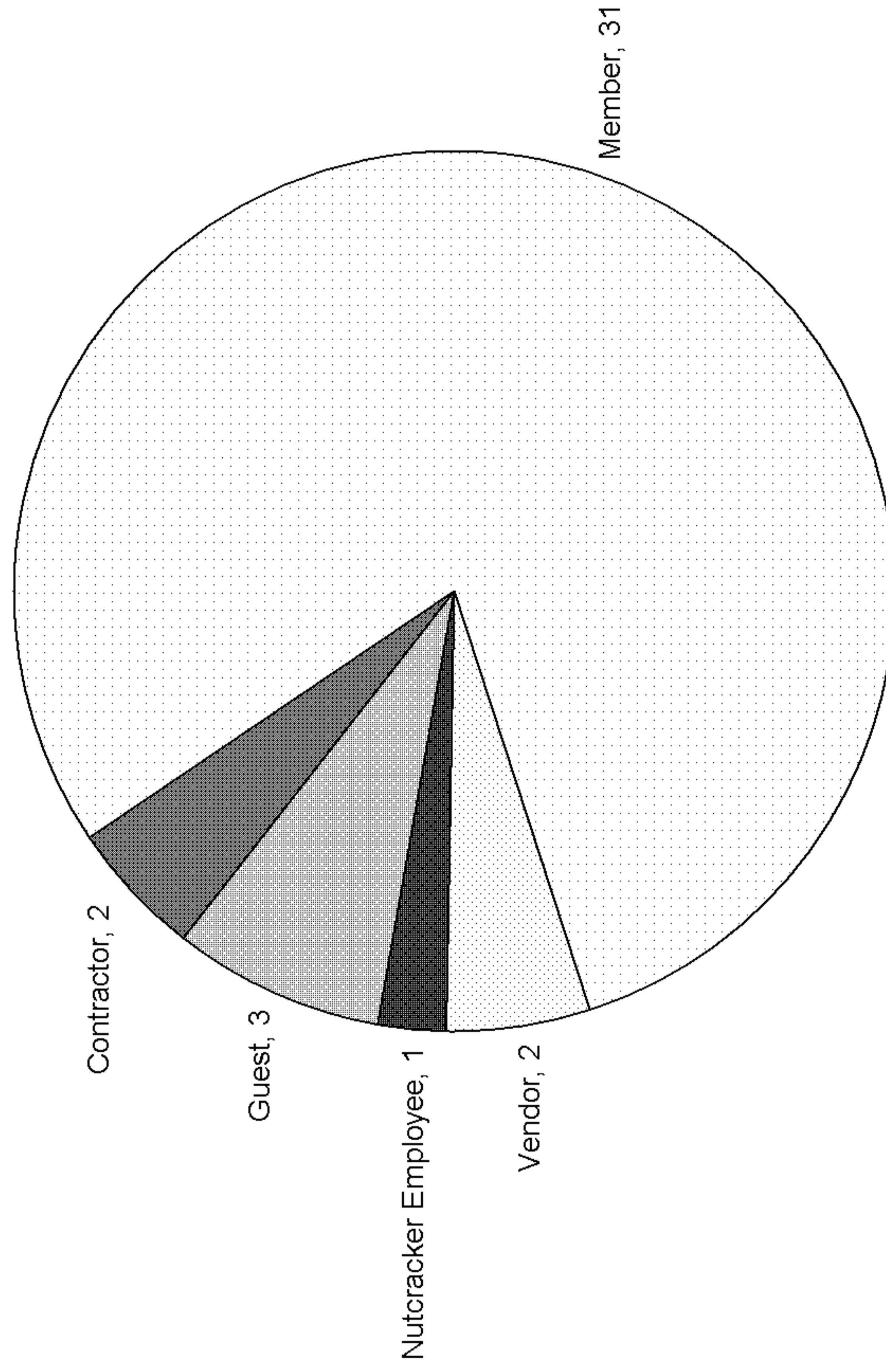
