## September 2008 Security Report

- 9-6-08 A member reported their car being egged in the night on Westover.
- 9-7-08 At 6:00pm a member reported two young males involved in vandalizing his and another member's house on Bellechase. The two individuals were identified and the responsible member was fined a flagrant violation.
- 9-12-08 At 7:30pm employees at the PAC called Security to help remove unruly youths from the area that refused to leave.
- 9-13-08 At 4:00pm a guest at the Inn required EMS attention in the lobby area of the Clubhouse. At 8:30pm a member on Ravenswood reported a high powered rifle being fired in the area. The sound turned out to be fireworks. At 11:20pm a house on Divot was found to have been T.P.ed.
- 9-14-08 At 2:30am a member on Sawgrass reported someone throwing rocks at his house. Security was called to the area but found no one.
- 9-15-08 At 7:45pm a member reported hearing gunfire in the 8400 block of Ravenswood. Security went to the area but did not hear any gunshots.
- 9-17-08 A member on Prospect Hill claimed the golf cart path was his property and did not want anyone on it. This caused disruption to many of the member's normal routines.
- 9-18-08 A member on Hampton reported a strange phone call that frightened her. Security and Hood County Sheriff's Office were notified.
- 9-20-08 Five young males were identified as individuals that rang doorbells and moved items around between the hours of 1:00 and 3:00am. The member on Elms Ct. where they were staying was charged with a flagrant violation.
- 9-22-08 At 11:30am Security responded to a call of domestic disturbance on Wedgefield. Hood County Sheriff's Office arrived and took over the situation.
- 9-25-08 The front desk called 911 due to the behavior of a boyfriend of an employee at the clubhouse. Hood County Sheriff's Deputies arrived and helped the individual in need.
- 9-27-08 At 11:30pm Security was called to the area of Hanging Moss for reports of someone banging on windows and shining a red laser pointer into people's houses. Security spotted and identified the individuals as they ran away.
- 9-28-08 Security responded to reports of banging on doors on Hickory Hill. While in the area, a golf cart was pulled over to be questioned but the occupants abandoned the golf cart and ran away. The golf cart was taken to the Security Office and the owner fined a Flagrant Violation for the driver running from Security. At 4:00am there was a report of barricades being placed in the road on Westover. Security went to the location and placed them back where they belong.




